

# Take a painting holiday with Jacqueline in the Barossa Valley

Explore your creative talents in a one-on-one, nurturing creative environment painting with established artist Jacqueline Coates at her studio in Kapunda with the focus on you and developing your paintings. Choose your own calendar dates for five days plus one evening, with the creative content tailored to your abilities.

Receive tuition, demonstrations and discussion as you paint with Jacqueline. Take home many finished pieces as well as exercises in technique and loads of inspiration to create more artwork after the program finishes.

Tuition is conducted at Jacqueline's stone barn home and studio and at her new Salon Rouge Gallery Workshop space in Kapunda. Landscape painting takes you into the picturesque undulating cropping lands of Kapunda, the Barossa and Clare Valleys. Landscape possibilities include hay bales, cropping patterns, views to the Riverlands, vineyards and orchards. Picnic whilst you paint en plein air alternating with studio based work.



Jacqueline provides a range of techniques and information you can confidently call upon. Tonal basics, colour mixing, drawing, exploring acrylics, effects such as crackling, gold leaf and impasto, exploring oils, encaustic (oil and beeswax), use of brushes, sponges and palette knives, and glazing. Design your program with Jacqueline to suit.

Jacqueline has taught literally hundreds of students from all over Australia and taught in New Zealand. Many of her students have gone on to exhibit and create careers of their own as artists. She was featured twice in Australian Artist magazine in 2008. She is known for her generous sharing of knowledge designed to fast forward your progress. Her approach is compassionate. Delete hesitation and procrastination from your vocabulary. It's easy when you are shown how.

Just over one hour and fifteen minutes direct drive. Kapunda is a safe and charming country town. You will be collected for painting excursions & pickups/drop offs as needed.
